### 2018 CRISP SPARKLING

This bubbly is a serious contender that punches well above its weight, so grab yourself a ringside seat as Pinot Grigio and Riesling square off in a battle for your senses. Riesling comes out swinging with a one-two punch of green apple and honey aromatics; Pinot counters with a mouthful of firm, ripe fruit. This one's a knockout, folks.

### 2018 PINOT GRIGIO

Tired of basic Pinot Grigio? Ours is anything but. The fruit quality is downright explosive – and green! Green melon. Green pear. Fresh picked green grapes. The texture is rich and glycerol-like and ends with the refreshing minerality that's the hallmark of the 2018 growing season.

### 2019 RIESLING

This wine contains multitudes. Heady candied aromatics of confectioners sugar and circus peanuts coexist with ripe nectarine and bright citrus. Rich, supple mouthfeel from four months of neutral oak aging, yet its bright, racy acidity leaves your palate clean and refreshed. Do I contradict myself? Very well, then.

### 2018 PINOT NOIR

Great wine isn't just about aroma and flavor; it's about the texture, too. Take your pick from any of the adjectives that get used to describe the mouthfeel of great Pinot Noir – silky, rich, supple – and our 2018 vintage showcases them in abundance.

### 2019 ROLA RED

The 2019 Rola Red will jump start your holiday spirit with its festive aromas of cinnamon, clove, and everything else you'd find in grandma's cherry cobbler. The luxurious mouthfeel offers up hints of star anise and black currant, and gentle oak aging ensures the fruit stays just as buoyant and vibrant as those visions of sugar plums dancing in your head. We guarantee there'll be no "bah humbugs" once this gets poured.
